The following requirements have been developed to serve the needs of Deauville Beach and Bay Association members, renters and guests. Your help is required to maintain a financially sound association as well as a clean, safe environment. **Please be courteous to lifeguards and badge checkers, and abide by the following:**

- 1. BEACH BADGES:** Season badges or daily wrist bands must be worn by all individuals 13 years of age and older while on the beach and to enter/re-enter the beach. Please have badges visible and show them to the badge checker when entering beach and/or when asked. The transfer of badges or bands is prohibited. Dues paying association members are provided 8 season badges per membership. Additional seasonal member badges are available for purchase when members pay their annual dues. Otherwise, daily badges can be purchased from the badge-checker at the beach entrances. Daily badges are \$15.00 per person/per day. The association reserves the right to limit the number of day badges sold on a given day, depending on beach crowds.
- 2. SWIMMING:** Swimming is permitted only in the areas protected by lifeguards, which are areas marked by conditional swim flags: Green = OK to swim; Yellow = use caution/OK to wade; Red= no swimming, Small children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Swimming is strictly prohibited when lifeguards are not on duty. The use of flotation devices, body and skim boards are permitted at discretion of lifeguards. Placement of the lifeguard stands are determined by surf conditions.
LIFEGUARDS WILL BE ON DUTY – A.M. TO P.M. beginning Juneth through Septemberth. Hours may vary based on weather conditions. Lifeguards are on duty for our safety, please obey their instructions at all times and be courteous to them.
- 3. DOGS AND PETS:** No dogs or pets are permitted on the beach at any time as per Brick Township ordinance 101-5. Service animals are permitted and must be registered with the DBBA board.
- 4. FOOD and DRINK:** If you bring food or drinks to the beach, please take any trash and/or containers back home with you. Do not leave anything on the beach or at the beach entrances. Glass is not permitted on the beach at any time.
- 5. FISHING/SURFING:** Fishing and surfing are only permitted outside of the bathing areas, marked by flags.
- 6. BIKE RIDING:** Bike riding is not permitted on walkways to beach.
- 7. VEHICLES and JET SKIS:** They are not permitted on the beach at any time during the season.
- 8. NO FIRES ARE ALLOWED ON THE BEACH.**
- 9. SMOKING:** No smoking of any kind is permitted on the beach during beach hours in beach season.
- 10. TENTS, TARPS and CANOPIES:** Are permitted but may not be larger than 8'x8'.
- 11. DUNES:** Please keep off the dunes which function to protect our community.
- 12. HOLES on BEACH:** Be sure to fill-in any holes that may have been dug during your time at beach, as holes can be hazardous to others, particularly at night. Deep holes may not be dug.

COMMUNITY INFORMATION and GUIDELINES:

1. GARBAGE COLLECTION: Household garbage is picked up on Monday mornings, and will only be picked up in Robo Cans. Additional Robo Cans can be purchased by contacting Brick Municipal. Recyclable collection is on every other Tuesday morning using the blue recycling bin provided to your home. Garbage and recyclables can also be brought to the Brick Police Sub-station on Rt. 35 on Saturday mornings. (www.twp.brick.nj.us/departments/public-works/recycling/) 800-55-RECYCLE

For Bulk pickup call 732- 451-4060 to arrange for pickup; do not leave it on the curb.

2. SPEEDING: Please be considerate and drive slowly on our community roadways. As our roads are very narrow and often have many vehicles in driveways and/or parked on the street visibility can be greatly reduced.

3. PARKING: Please obey “No Parking” signs on our streets as per Brick Township ordinances. Violators will be ticketed.

4. DISTURBING NOISE: Please be considerate of your neighbors. Loud and excessive noise, music, etc. are a nuisance per Brick Ordinance and must be quieted by 11:00 pm.
